less than a nickel per high. The amount of THC consumed is dependent on multiple variables, including how hard the draw, how long the draw, and how long the vaper is held in the lungs. Vaping (both

THC and nicotine) among our youth is at epidemic proportions. Sweet and fruity flavors, social acceptance, low cost, and the ease to conceal make it attractive to kids, enticing them to use vaping devices they might otherwise avoid.

Designed with the younger audience in mind, Zigazoo offers a platform where kids can explore, create, and watch videos in an environment that prioritizes safety and educational content.





- Restrict access to lethal means like firearms and medications.
- Foster strong friendships, in person or online, to provide support and hope.
- Cultivate hope through encouragement and assistance.
- Provide support at home and school, especially from parents.
- Offer psychotherapy, such as CBT and DBT, along with family therapy.
- Conduct routine depression screenings and refer to psychiatrists for early intervention.
- Monitor technology use, particularly social media, to combat cyberbullying.
- Educate adolescents about mental health and available resources.
- Provide intentional follow-up and ongoing support after a suicide attempt.
- Embrace and accept youth identity, especially for LGBTQIA+ individuals.

By implementing these strategies collectively, we can mitigate the tragic impact of youth suicide and foster healthier, more resilient adolescents.
